

Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports



The Tomah Area School District is using Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports (PBIS) as a process for creating safer and more effective schools. PBIS focuses on improving a school's ability to teach and support the positive behavior of all students. We recognize that it is very important to be clear and consistent with behavior expectations, to teach respectable behaviors, and to provide positive reinforcement when students are following the rules. Our main goal is to create safe environments where teachers can teach and students can learn.

We hope that you support our program. Ask your child about earning paws in their classroom and how they are acknowledged for good behavior. As part of our basic philosophy to encourage students to excel, continuous recognition is given to students who have demonstrated outstanding citizenship. Students displaying positive behavior at Lemonweir Elementary are recognized in a variety of ways including special events/assemblies, announcements, bulletin boards, individual Incentives, and more.

We are also using behavioral referrals to inform administration, staff, and parents of problem behavior. Data is kept on the number of behavior referrals and problems are addressed immediately by looking at where problems occur most often and why the problem is occurring.
