

Condensed Activities Code (2023-24)

1. The code is in affect 24 hrs/day, 7 days/week, 365 days/yr.
2. Academics
 - a. Grades are checked every 21 to 23 days (Mid-Quarter and Quarter)
 - i. Mid-Quarter – The Mid-quarter reports will be run in the morning on the following dates: - Oct. 3, Dec. 11, Feb. 22, and May 1 . The ineligible list will become active on the third day following the published grade report. Students become ineligible if they have more than one (1) failing grade (F/WF/I) .
 - ii. Quarter - **Students become ineligible if they have 1 or more failing grades (F/WF/I), with one exception. If a student has just 1 failing grade and their Grade Point Average for that Quarter is 2.75 or higher they remain eligible.**
- Nov. 6, Jan. 22, March 25, and June 3
 - iii. Students must be passing **ALL** their classes to regain eligibility.
 - b. Grades from 4th Quarter carry over to the fall of the next school year.
3. Attendance
 - a. Absent due to Illness more than 50% of day
 - i. Must be present 223 minutes HS, 221 minutes MS
MS – 11:35am/HS – 11:38am
 - b. Any unexcused absences during the day = Ineligible for practice/competition that day
4. Behavior
 - a. Criminal Charges or Convictions do not need to occur for a student to be in violation of the code.
 - b. Selling, Delivering or Manufacturing Alcohol, Tobacco, or controlled Substances,.... = PERMANENT SUSPENSION
 - c. Using, Possessing, or Buying Alcohol, Tobacco, or controlled substances, **including “Vaping”**.... = Suspended up to 50% of the Season
 - d. Other Criminal Conduct such as Vandalism, Theft, Criminal Trespassing, Disorderly Conduct = Suspended up to 50% of the Season
 - e. Conduct Unbecoming of a Student Athlete (Suspension in or out of School, Truancy, Hazing, Act of Intimidation, Academic Cheating, Plagiarism, Unsportsmanlike Behavior, or any conduct that adversely affects the management of the school and its efficiency) = Suspended up to 50% of the Season.
5. It is the participant’s parent/guardian responsibility to notify the Activities Director or Building Administrator when they become aware their child violated the Activities Code.
