Tomah High School Bowling Team Code of Conduct

- 1. All bowlers must abide by the Wisconsin High School Bowling Club Policies and Procedures (www.bowlwi.com), Tomah Area School Activities Code and the Team Rules.
- 2. Practice will be on Monday, Tuesdays, and Thursdays (Check calendar for days). There will be no practice on days that school gets out early or is not in session.
- 3. Practice will begin at 4:00 pm and end at 5:00 pm. If a bowler is late for practice due to having to stay late after school, they will need a note from the school excusing them.
- 4. No unexcused absences will be tolerated, if the bowler does not have a verified excuse for an absence, they will sit the next match. Bring a note or inform another bowler if you are going to be late or absent.
- 5. Bus transportation is provided for the bowling team for their matches. Matches are typically on Sundays starting at 10:00 a.m. If a bowler wants to ride home with their parents, they must sign a waiver at that match to do so. I will have a waiver at each match to sign.
- 6. Uniforms for the matches will be Tomah Bowling shirts with black slacks or black jeans. No shorts, spandex, jogging pants. If you have a question about whether it is ok to wear, ask a coach.
- 7. Bowlers may wear black, yellow or white t-shirt under collared shirt, shirts will be tucked in during matches. Bowlers can wear a different shirt to the match but will change into team uniform before match.
- 8. At no time will hats or any type of head gear be worn during practice or during match play. Hats can be worn to practice or match but then must be removed before practice begins.
- 9. No spectators in the settee or concourse area during practices. This means no friends, parents or relatives. I do not want any distractions while we are practicing. This is our time to work on improving your bowling skills.
- 10. During practice or matches no bowler will have cell phones, MP 3's/music, or any other electronic devices in the settee or concourse area. Bowlers can have a cell phone for emergencies or to contact parents but not to be used as a distraction.
- 11. All bowlers will remain in the immediate bowling area while the practice and the competition are in progress unless excused by the Coach or Assistant Coaches.
- 12. Deliberate fouling, unusually loud or vulgar language or abuse of equipment and facilities is prohibited; bowlers can be removed from competition or penalized by the Coaches.
- 13. <u>No food allowed</u>, water or soda are to remain in the concourse area which is the area behind the settee area ONLY. Bowlers have time to get a snack between school and bowling.
- 14. Violation Sequence: Violation 1; will result in verbal warning.

Violation 2; will result in letter point removed.

<u>Violation 3; will be considered for removal from practice and all</u> competition.
