TOMAH/ SPARTA HIGH SCHOOL HOCKEY RULES

2023-2024 Season

Philosophy of the Tomah/Sparta High School Hockey Program

- 1. Arrive every day expecting to be a good teammate.
- 2. Arrive every day prepared to learn. It is difficult to successfully teach or coach a person who does not want to learn. The more you invest the more you'll get out of the sport and the program.
- 3. Good teammates view the player-coach relationship as a cooperative effort to develop the player to be the best they can be.
- 4. Failure is the opportunity to begin again with more experience.

Role of a Tomah/Sparta High School Hockey Program Player

- 1. We assume you want to be the best athlete you can be.
 - a. You will not be allowed to settle for less than your best
- 2. We assume you want to play on a successful team.
 - a. Our practices, conditioning program and game plans will be designed to develop success.
 - b. Decisions will be made with the priority being the Team, the individual must come second period!
- 3. We assume you want to graduate with the highest grades you are capable of earning.
 - a. You will be responsible to the team to be the best student you can be.
- 4. We assume you want to become the best person you can be.
 - a. You represent our team as long as you are part of the Tomah/ Sparta High School Hockey Program.
 - b. Your character is a reflection of you, your parents, the Tomah Sparta High School Hockey Program, and the Tomah / Sparta Communities.
 - c. You will understand that these are benefits that come with being a member of our team, but along with those benefits you will be held accountable for your actions.

Practices:

Practice is our classroom, school rules apply. Unreasonable and disruptive behavior will result in some form of corrective/disciplinary action. Each year something new comes up and as coaches we will respond in a manner to promote the betterment of the team.

If corrective/disciplinary action involves removal from practice, the practice becomes unexcused and the guidelines for absences apply. If at any time a player commits an action with the intent to injure another player, they will be removed from practice and may be subject to further corrective/disciplinary action. Off Ice Sessions are a part of practice.

Absences:

- 1. Any absence from practice, game or other scheduled activity must be communicated to the head coach prior to the absence occurring to be considered excused. In case of emergency or last minute illness, please communicate to the head coach as soon as reasonably possible.
- 2. Deer hunting, driver's education, over sleeping, work, or unexcused school absence will not be considered excused.
- 3. If a player is unexcused from a practice, they will miss a game for each occurrence. After a 3rd unexcused absence a player may be dismissed from the team for the remainder of season.
- 4. School policies covering athletic code violations and grading requirement policies will apply.

Curfews: It is very important that players receive the optimum amount of rest during the season. The correct amount of sleep will enable players to maintain their physical conditioning the following day. On a night before a game, all players will be expected to be in their homes at a reasonable time. The time will be communicated to the team by the coaches after consultation with the team captains. Failures to meet curfew will be treated similar to absences.

Bus rides: All players are expected to ride the bus to and from away games. If, on a non-school night (no school the following day) your family is traveling somewhere in the area of the game for a family function, the player may ride with the parent following the game if prior (before game day) arrangements are made.

Cell phones: Cell phones or electronic communications devices are not to be used in the locker room or during bus transportation without a coach's approval.

Insubordination: Any player who demonstrates insubordination towards coaches or team members will receive some form of corrective/disciplinary action. This could be as little as a few push-ups or severe enough to be removed from the team. We are a team, if you have issues or concerns with the way something is going on, you need to address them with the head coach.

Lettering/Awards policy: Every member of the Tomah/ Sparta High School Hockey Program who participates in a minimum of twenty six periods, in a positive manner, at the varsity level, will be eligible to "letter". If a player commits an athletic code violation during the season they will not be eligible for team\ post season awards. The coaches may use discretion considering which players "letter".

General: These guidelines and expectations are defined to help create a positive experience for all participants in the Tomah Sparta High School Hockey Program. They cannot cover all circumstances but will serve as a guide. Coaches will respond appropriately and consistently to situations that may arise with school guidelines, hockey program guidelines, and generally accepted rules of conduct.
