Today we commemorate **HOLOCAUST DAY OF REMEMBRANCE**. It marks the anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising. Led by 23-year-old Mordechai Anielewicz, this was the largest and symbolically the most important Jewish uprising during WWII. At least 7,000 Jews died fighting and hiding, as the Germans burned the ghetto building by building. Approximately 7,000 were captured by SS and police at the end of the fighting and were sent to the Treblinka killing center where they were murdered. About 42,000 people were captured during the uprising and were sent to concentration and forced-labor camps. They were eventually murdered in the November 1943 2-day shooting spree known as Operation Harvest Festival. Days of Remembrance ceremonies to commemorate the victims and survivors of the Holocaust are linked to the dates of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising.
