- Historically famous/impacting speeches

### **Universal Truths**

This is where you will analyze a specific piece of the book based on how well you think the author is doing.

- Writing Style
- Information
- How convincing is the author?
- This is not about whether you agree or disagree with the author but how well the author approached the writing.

### **Government & Current Events**

- Politicians and Policies
- Laws, bills, petitions, etc.
- Elections
- News Stories
- Local, National, and/or Worldly Events
- Student Government issues and concerns

### Observations/Personal Experiences

- Tendencies you've noticed about public (or private) behavior (at concerts, museums, ball games, in libraries, restaurants, church, etc.)
- Events and happenings in your own life
- Events and happenings in the lives of people you know
- Personal goals, ambitions, plans, etc.
- Personal schedule, routine, agenda, etc.
