

Dear Advanced Placement Students for Sophomore English - AP Prep:

<u>Welcome</u> to your second year of AP English... or, if you are new, welcome to the program! As part of the AP English program, you are required to complete the reading and work for the required novel, *To Kill a Mockingbird*, by Harper Lee. Summer reading is important because it gives students a better "book background" to choose from when writing for the AP exam.

## ASSIGNMENT COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Read To Kill a Mockingbird.
  - You will check out a copy of the book for me.
- 2. Thoroughly complete all 6 of the deeper thinking questions, supported with quotes and analysis. Be sure to meet sentence length requirements for each section.
  - Please type your answers. A link to all documents will be available on our English Department webpage for you to make a copy of. I will also be adding you all to a Schoology page before the end of this school year.
  - If you are unable to type your answers (don't have access to a computer this summer), I recommend that you handwrite your answers down while reading the book and typing them up when you get your Chromebook back. Chromebooks will be handed out the 2nd week of August.
  - This assignment will be submitted to turnitin.com on the first day of school!
- 3. Be prepared to write an essay and take a test related to this novel during the first week of school!
- 4. Read a 2nd book and complete the reflection assignment!
  - The Tomah library has great book options; you can also check out free books across from Mrs. Neve's room (130).
- 5. Be prepared to give a book talk based on your choice book during the first week of school!

Bring your book and have your documents ready on the first day of class. We will submit to turnitin.com. Failure to complete the summer reading assignment in its entirety will result in the student receiving ZERO points.

This failing grade will potentially affect participation in clubs and sports this fall.

Late work policy will be applied to any/all late submissions.

- Summative Work 10% Deduction every day, up to a total of %50
