

Lloyd "Feets" Cramer Memorial Scholarship

Description: One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Tomah High School student-athlete.

Scholarship Mission Statement: This scholarship is to be given to honor the memory of a true Tomah legend. During his time at Tomah High School, Lloyd "Feets" Cramer was a starter for successful football, baseball, basketball and track teams including helping lead Tomah to 3 consecutive trips to the state basketball tournaments and being the quarterback on an undefeated state championship football team in 1943. "Feets" continued to give back to Tomah athletics throughout his life including contributions such as helping establish youth football and basketball in Tomah, umpiring baseball and coaching youth basketball for 52 years. His memory is that of a great athlete and a man who dedicated his life to community service.

In his memory this scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating senior from Tomah High School who best exemplifies three qualities that "Feets" stood for during his life: athletics, academics and community service.
